General Information

Registration by mail: For rendezvous this year we are asking for you to pre-register. The pre-register cost is \$45 for Old Timers and \$40 for Young Bucks and covers your camping from Thursday through Saturday night. If you plan on coming in earlier there is an extra charge of \$5 per night per member. Onsite registration will be available and will cost \$50 for Old Timers and \$45 for Young Bucks. All attendees must leave the campground by Sunday.

Rev. Luis Velazquez began his Royal Ranger Ministry in 1980 when his pastor asked him to take training for a ministry for boys. Since day one Brother Luis fell in love with the ministry and how it effectively ministered to boys.

He has held the positions of Area Commander, Manhattan Sectional Commander, Long Island Sectional Commander, District Aide de Camp, District Productions Coordinator, Deputy District Commander and he now serves as The District Director for the Spanish Eastern District.

Brother Luis has also helped in his local churches as Children's Pastor, Education Minister, Youth Pastor and is an Associate Pastor at Calvary Pentecostal Church in Brooklyn New York. He is also the Founder and Director of a puppet and clown ministry called "A Time to Laugh" which he uses to train young people on how to minister to children.

Professionally Brother Luis is a New York City schoolteacher where he has been teaching for the last 31 years. He has been married to his wife Jasmin for 32 years and they have two daughters, Jasmin Crystal who serves as a Girls Ministry Sectional Representative in the New York District and Ruth Elizabeth who serves as a Ranger Kids Leader in the local outpost. He joined the FCF in 1986 and has taken the name of Three Arrows.



Special Invitation

Typically this event is limited to FCF members, but for 2017 we are opening this up to all Royal Rangers. Come and participate in special events where frontier skills are demonstrated and practiced. Take part in competitions that promote the development of these skills and reflect the excitement, color, and flair of frontier America.

In order to preserve the primitive look and feel so unique to FCF we'd like to keep modern camping equipment either in a separate area or possibly at one end of the camp. If this is a hardship for your outpost, please let me know and we can discuss. FCF style clothing won't be a requirement in camp either, we just ask that if you have it, you bring it and wear it to add to the camp appearance.

2017 Voyagers Territory Rendezvous Notes

- Participants should strive to be in FCF attire soon after arrival and for the duration of the camp.
- No hand guns are allowed at Royal Rangers events.
- No loaded firearms are allowed in camp (this includes percussion caps).
- There are to be no modern shelters in the area designated as primitive.
- Lighting is to be period as well. If you must have Coleman or electric lights these are to remain inside your shelter.
- All modern items, such as water containers and coolers, should be covered. This will make photography much more authentic in appearance.
- Your fires are your responsibility. Keep them under control. Firefighting equipment (sand and water buckets) should be on hand in your camp.
- First aid will be available at the registration camp.
- Campers are responsible for all their actions.
- Schedules, event results, news and notices will be posted at the registration area.
- Absolutely no dogs or pets allowed in camp.
- Commanders are responsible for the safety and well being of boys in their care. Be aware of where and what they are doing.
- Quiet time is the hours of 11pm to daylight. Please be kind to those around you.
- All vehicles will come in on the service road, unload, and then be driven back to parking lot. After camp is over and you have packed, have your camp completely ready to load prior to bringing in your vehicle, quickly load and take vehicle back to the parking lot.
- Shooting will be supervised by an official NRA/NMLRA range safety officer.
- All persons shooting a black powder firearm must have an approved black powder card to present to the range officers. This may be the FCF shooters card, NRA Certification card, or NMLRA Certification card. All shooters must have their firearm checked by a range safety officer prior to shooting.
- All garbage and trash will be hauled away; we will clean the entire camp.
- All persons under 18 at the time of the rendezvous must have the "permission slip" signed by parent or guardian authorizing them to shoot and handle a firearm - Black Powder/Knife Permission Slip.
- Visitors are only allowed in camp from 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. Thursday through Saturday. Event registered campers are responsible for all their visitors on the Territorial site during the visiting hours. Please abide by these rules.

Turn Right off of US 63 (4.1 miles) onto Woods Store-Etoile Rd.
Go .5 miles on Woods Store-Etoile Rd. to camp entrance on the left.

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From Bowling Green:

Go North on I-65. Exit onto Cumberland Parkway.
