In this world's culture whenever we confront an unbridled desire we are surely in the presence of a tragedy-in-the-making.

Definition for unbridled: Not controlled or restrained. The Lack of self-control.

Example sentences for unbridled:

Poverty must be addressed, but unbridled development will only bring short-term relief.

The unbridled greed of the few has resulted in great damage to global economies and society.

Free, unbridled capitalism is once again acting to badly disrupt orderly economic activity.

Clearly unbridled access to capital results in both illusory ideas, and crises-which solves nothing in regards to income inequalities. Unbridled capitalism does not work unless a government is willing to step in to put a

cap on capitalism. Two examples are monopolies such as, energy industries, and soon as the war on the independent farmers is won; “food.”

([1 Corinthians 6:12](#)) All things are lawful unto me, but all things are not expedient: all things are lawful for me, but I will not be brought under the power of any.

THOUGHT TO PONDER:

The unbridled spirit with creativity needs to be uncompromisingly tempered with constraint.

When our youngest daughter, Jessica wanted to get a horse, we got a three year old appaloosa. Good horse but knew nothing! As I watched Jessica in the ring as she was trying to slip around behind unaware to the horse and would use a whip lightly to buff the horse, then immediately she would take the whip and rub it over the horse as she spoke softly and loved on her. I ask, “What are doing?” She replied, “The first thing you need to teach a horse is to pay attention, and second the whip is not a weapon to punish, but a tool of instruction.” ([Matthew 13:21](#)) I thought what a revelation of trials and tribulations, that is what God wants for us, “to have root in yourself that goes down deep by the river of life in Him ([Psalms 1:3](#)). After several months Jessie had Nina, (that’s the mare’s name) broke to saddle and doing all sorts of stuff. Several weeks had passed when one day I was out by the barn and Jess called to me to come over and watch something as she worked Nina. “Now get this;” Jessie had no rope or bridle on this horse. She had Nina as taught, to always keeping eyes on her for instructions, “what a metaphor.” Jessica was on one side of the ring and Nina on the other as she directed the horse to move clock wise around the ring. With different signals she had Nina doing different gates, and then stopped her and had he go in the other direction. Jessie then stopped Nina and with her hands rotating one over the other like maybe pulling on a rope to pull the horse forward, but with no lead rope; Nina walked up to her just as if there was a lead. This friend, to me was another revelation to a new perspective for the unbridled spirit.

When my family migrated from Appalachians in Eastern Kentucky, my dad was a young man. Be that as it may, folks had a lot of old sayings they would quote now and again. Believe me friend, when I say; “I have derived most were biblical.” One such saying was, “Don’t Peter out on me now.” City folk might say, “don’t become distracted.” God wants to teach us to keep our eyes upon Jesus. When Jesus was walking across the water He said to Peter, “come”, Peter begins to walked on water, Peter got distracted, and Peter begin to compromise seeing the storm.
