DEVOTION:

"our strength—His Power and Authority"

Thoughts for Today: Ephesians 1:19-23

In 1 Corinthians 12:12-27 and 15:25-28, Paul also used this analogy of the church being the body of Christ. And in our passage today, he once again draws upon our understanding of

how the church (as the body of Christ) is to work with Him as its head. Paul's emphasis is upon the Lordship of Christ over the church -- just as the head dictates and controls the actions of our physical bodies.

What's really interesting is Paul's statement that "God placed all things under His feet." Therefore, if we're His body, it means that all things (by extension) are under our feet as well. These three verses (Ephesians 1:21-23) represent some of the greatest in the Bible related to the authority of the believer. When we come to Christ in belief and faith, we also share in His throne and the authority it represents. And then, provided we act in accordance with His will, He gives us His divine power and dominion.

In our passage today, the great point Paul makes is: The same amazing power God used to raise Jesus from the dead is the **SAME** power we believers have been given in Christ. So it's not just a tiny bit of power. It is as much as, and equal to, the power God applied when He raised Jesus. Which is more than enough to accomplish His will in our lives. (Romans 8:11) He that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken you, if He dwell in you.

All too often people say, "I'm addicted," yet God says, "You're free!" We say, "I'm hurt, damaged, and beyond repair." God says, "You're as whole as you allow Me to make you." We say, "I need counseling, therapy and prescription drugs to help me cope with life." God says, "You don't need anything except Me."

At the center of all this, Christ rules the church. The church, you see, is not peripheral to the world; the world is peripheral to the church. The church is Christ's body, in which he speaks and acts, by which he fills everything with his presence." Isn't that an amazing statement? (Acts 27:21) In the same way that a ship is not complete without its crew, or a District Network is incomplete without patriots, (you). Jesus Christ has **chosen** the church to be the completion of His body on the earth. The will of the Father is to see His children growing together -- interacting, studying, praying, worshipping, sharing, and loving one another. The key point that many powerless Christians ignore is this, "that we must only take direction from the Lord." Christ has been appointed the "head over everything for the church". So if we're not being led by Jesus, we're not going to be able to tap into His power and authority to Be **STRONG**.

Based upon God's divine order, the world is secondary when compared to the church. Not the other way around. Yet, all too often we place the world's agenda and priorities above the Lord's. Have you prioritized attending church, (Royal Rangers) and participating at Pow-Wow, or just spending a week day with boys as a part of the body of Christ?

Questions to Ponder:

Many will read those words and say, "That's nice sounding, but really impractical. In this day and age we need greater tools to deal with our problems."

Are you sure? Have you allowed things to get out of the Lord's divine order? Why isn't God enough? What needs to be re-ordered? God has already placed ALL things (powers, dominions, etc.) under the feet of Jesus (and therefore under ours as well). Nothing is over His head, and nothing is outside of His control. Including whatever problem you might be facing right now. Will you go to Him? Will you tap into His amazing power and authority over all circumstances? Will you seek His divine will? Be **STRONG** in His Power.
